Decorating a Guest Bedroom

1. Make guests feel welcome and special.
 - Add fresh cut flowers by the bed on tray @ side table.
 - Place a carafe and glass by bed.
 - Place a few toiletries such as sheet spray or fancy soap on dresser or tray.

2. Make room for their luggage and clothes.
 - A simple portable luggage rack, keeps luggage out of the way.
 - Provide extra hangers in closet.
 - Clear out a few dresser drawers for their use.
 - Clear dressing table surfaces before guests arrive, so they have an area to spread out their toiletries.

3. Have comfortable chair or chaise in corner for reading and putting on shoes.

4. Have a few books or magazines for them to read.

5. Stacks of fluffy pillows make for an inviting cozy bed.
 - Make sure you have a place for guests to place them, so they don't end up on the floor.
 - Keep quilts and blankets in an armoire or closet for extra warmth on chilly winter nights.

6. If room permits have a desk in bedroom, for laptop use or putting on makeup.

7. All white bedding gives a luxury hotel feel.

8. Keep walls a soothing airy color.

9. Twin beds can provide flexibility.
 - Allows for multiple guests.
 - Can be pulled together to make a king-size bed.
